

Turkey Shoot Rules and Regulations

All shoots are Stock (unmodified shotgun) shoots.

What do you do?

- Shoot shotguns.
- You need to bring your own shotguns (12 gauge or 20 gauge)
- We use Turkey Targets, closest to the bullseye wins the round.
- Targets will be placed on the target line by the range master.

The cost is \$5.00 per round (ammunition will be provided by the FCWA)

The profits from the turkey shoot go to funding for new range supplies.

Prizes vary and will be available the day of the event.

RULES

- Stock Shoot Rules
- Registration opens at 9 am and closes at 10 am
- Shoot begins shortly after registration closes.
- Max choke restrictions is factory full
- All shotguns will be inspected by the Range Master
- Stoot at the turkey targets with bullseye on the target
- Max 36" barrel length
- Scopes/RDS systems are NOT permitted. Open sights only -aka rifle/bead
- All shooting will be from the standing unsupported firing position.
- Slings permitted.
- If there is a tie, those shooters will shoot again, if there is still a tie after the second shot, the shooters will shoot again. If no one hits the bullseye the shooter closest to the bullseye will be the winner. (All tie breakers additional rounds will be provided by the club
- If we youth under 16, there will be a "minor" shoot-they must be accompanied by an adult. If there are not enough for a separate shoot, minors will be allowed to participate if accompanied by an adult.
- There will be ladies only shoot.
- All Range Safety Rules Shall Apply. The range officer has discretion of removal of personnel due to gross safety violations or poor sportsmanship
