

FCWA Hunting Club Rules

The following are the club rules for the 2022/23 hunting season approved by the Board of Directors August 4, 2022

Hunting Lease Dues:

All member's dues shall be paid before July 1 for each year. The total cost is \$420 with a total of 2100 acres for hunting. Dues not paid by July 1 forfeit their spot and it is now open for new members. Membership is limited to 50 hunters. There will be no refund for membership without a paid member to take your place. When your dues are paid, you will be assigned a PIN number. If you were a member last season you will be assigned the same PIN, IF YOUR DUES ARE NOT PAID ON TIME (July 1) your PIN may be assigned to someone who has paid their dues.

LEASE Membership is for 1 person, it is not a family membership. Small Game and Predator hunting is allowed in accordance with the State of Georgia Regulations AFTER DEER SEASON.

All members shall abide by Georgia State Hunting Regulations while on the FCWA hunting lease property. This is a downloadable APP for your phone and takes about two minutes to process your kill).

Immediate Family: Children under 16 may hunt with their parent or member.

Guest Policy:

Each member is allowed two guests per year. A HUNTING LEASE GUEST MAY NOT BE A MEMBER OF FCWA. After one (1) visit, visitors are expected to join as members, unless they live more than 200 miles from the club.

Sign-in and sign out- Members will tag their hunting location on the sign-in

board with their personal PIN ID, pushpin supplied by the club. You must tag your pushpin while hunting and remove your tag from pushpin upon returning from the woods.

A harvest sheet is located next to the sign-in board, to record your harvest, all animals taken should be recorded. This will allow us to monitor the harvest.

Stand Locations:

A permanent 150 yard NO STAND radius around the club-built BOX Blinds.

Members are allowed to hang personal stands, ladders, blinds etc. anywhere on the lease property. (150 yard radius and out of eyesight while hunting). Your personal (PIN) number must be visible on your stand or tree.

Updated and board approve rule change

All club stands are on a first-come/ first serve basis with their locations marked on property map.

With the exception of club stands and your own personal stands, no hunter may pin-in until 45 minutes before legal shooting hours begin or three hours before sunset.

What this rule does is guarantees the stand owner can hunt their own stand as long as they sign in 45 minutes before sunrise or if they plan to hunt in the evening, three hours before sunset.

It's frustrating when a hunter buys a stand, hauls it into the woods, sets-up a food plot or feeder, drives two hours only to show up and find someone pinned into their stand.

Migratory Birds:

There will be no waterfowl hunting after 1500 (3:00PM). Duck ponds are open for hunting on Wednesday and Saturday only. Hunting may take place until dark on the last weekend of the season

ATV Restrictions:

All vehicles with the exception of ATVs and UTVs must access Kranart lease property from County line Road.

All vehicles will require a FCWA sticker with the PIN # on it.

ATV use will be kept to a minimum during hunting season. Joy riding is not permitted during hunting season.

Only Lease Members may use roadways on the Lease Property, they are NOT open to GENERAL Membership of FCWA even during closed hunting season.

Mandatory Workdays:

There will be two mandatory workdays for anyone that is on the FCWA hunting lease.

Updated and board approve rule change

Members are required to attend two of the six scheduled official work days per hunting season- July-June. In lieu of work days, members may submit evidence to the hunt club president of independent work on the property that benefited the hunting club as a whole. Planting individual food plots or paid work does not count as volunteering. Hunters who do not meet the work day requirements will be required to pay a \$50 fine per work day missed (max\$100) in order to rejoin the club the following season.

The Deer Cooler:

Located in the pole barn for members convenience. Deer should not be left in the cooler for more than 10 days. Please clean up and remove discarded items to the boneyard (the first gravel driveway to the right after you cross the bridge when exiting the club property.). It is not the responsibility of paid employees of FCWA, to dispose off GUT PILES.

All members are fully expected to adhere to the club lease rules, and State of Georgia Hunting Regulations and understand that membership could be terminated for failure to do so!!!
